Cell Phones

Teachers can specify when cell phone use is acceptable during class time and rehearsals. They must be put away, and at no point placed on music stands. If students are dealing with an emergency, they must communicate with their teacher. We have cell phone pouches where we may ask students to place phones if they become a distraction.

Instrument Loan/Rental/Purchase

Regular home practice is integral to achieving success. We are fortunate to have many instruments that are serviced annually to keep in excellent condition which we can loan out. Conversely, we can provide you with information if you wish to rent or purchase an instrument.

Course Fees

Fees off-set the cost of special workshops and performances, guest artists, festival entries, busing, repairs, materials (sheet music, scripts, costumes, make-up, sound and lighting equipment). This is NOT an instrument rental fee.

Grade 9 and 10 Open Instrumental Courses: \$25 Open Dance Courses: \$10 Auditioned Performing Arts Courses: \$30 per course (therefore \$60 for the dual course PA programs)

We ask that the fee be paid by Friday September 29th using School Cash On-line.

Uniforms

All students need to purchase an O'Neill PA t-shirt through the department. Black bottoms (pants or skirt with black tights) and black dress shoes are your responsibility to source. No ripped jeans or track pants. Shoes must be all black.

Some performances will require Dress Blacks. The bottoms are the same as above. The top may be a black long sleeved dress shirt, neckline should be collared or a fairly high crew or V neckline. If choosing a dress, hem should be below the knee and black tights are required.
