### **Rehearsal Schedule**

The rehearsal schedule is posted in the Department Google Classroom and on our website. Success is dependent upon a consistent commitment from **all** students involved. Please avoid scheduling appointments during rehearsals. For school conflicts, communicate with the leaders of each activity to reach a compromise.

#### **Media Consent Forms**

Students in the arts programs at O'Neill have numerous performances in the school and community which require media consent. For example, your child may be filmed or photographed during a performance. The consent form covers a four year term. If you have completed a form in a previous year, we will have it on file. Forms will be sent home with students requiring one.

#### **Cell Phones**

Cell phones should be on airplane mode and out of sight. Teachers can specify when cell phone use is acceptable. They at no point should be placed on music stands. If students are dealing with an emergency, they must communicate with their teacher. We have cell phone pouches where we may ask students to place phones if they become a distraction.

#### **Instrument Loan/Rental/Purchase**

Regular home practice is integral to achieving success. We are fortunate to have many instruments that are serviced annually to keep in excellent condition which we can loan out. Conversely, we can provide you with information if you wish to rent or purchase an instrument.

### **Course Fees**

Fees off-set the cost of special workshops and performances, guest artists, festival entries, busing, repairs, materials (sheet music, scripts, costumes, make-up, sound and lighting equipment). This is NOT an instrument rental fee.

# **Uniforms**

All students need to have an O'Neill PA t-shirt. Black bottoms (pants or skirt below the knee with black tights), black socks or tights and black dress shoes. No ripped jeans or track pants. Shoes must be ALL black.

Some performances will require Dress Blacks. The bottoms are the same as above. The top may be a black long-sleeved dress shirt, neckline should be collared or a fairly high crew or V neckline. If choosing a dress, hem should be below the knee and black tights are required.
